- ✚ The presenting author should be registered for the conference.
- ✚ The Abstract must be sent to **kcabstract1@gmail.com**
- ✚ Last date of Submission is **14th February, 2023**
- ✚ The Abstract must include title, author's name, introduction, methods, results and conclusion.

CRITERIA FOR SCIENTIFIC PAPER PRESENTATION

- ✚ Number of PPT Slides: 15-20
- ✚ Time for presentation: 6 minutes followed by 2 minutes discussion

CRITERIA FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

- ✚ Measurement: 4x3 Ft
- ✚ Type of Material: Printed Banner or Flex
- ✚ Time for Presentation: 5 minutes
- ✚ Name of Candidate or Institution should not be mentioned on Poster.
